## When Was The Last Time You Left \$1,000 "On The Table"?

The Arizona  
Private School  
Tuition Tax  
Credit law was  
enacted in 1997  
giving taxpayers  
a **GREAT  
OPPORTUNITY.**



Taxpayers can **Choose** to pay up to  
\$1,000 less in income tax to the State  
of Arizona and give it instead to help  
pay the tuition of students at private  
schools.

For example, a typical family of four  
that earns \$60,000 per year would  
pay the state of Arizona \$1,100 in  
state tax. If that same family  
contributes \$1,100 to S.T.A.Y., the  
family's **tax liability will be reduced**  
by \$1,000. Instead of owing Arizona  
\$1,100 in state tax, that family would  
owe the state of Arizona \$100.

Actual tuition grants are entirely to the discretion of the association. The Arizona statute prohibits the designation of your dependent as a potential recipient.

Donations are used for tuition grants for K-12 students attending private schools in Arizona. Tuition grants are awarded without regard to the student's race, color, gender, handicap, familial status, or national origin. At least ninety percent of the donated funds are used for tuition grants. Decisions awarding tuition grants are the sole responsibility of the association. Admission decisions are the exclusive responsibility of the school. The maximum Arizona State tax credit is \$1,000 per year for married taxpayers or \$500 for single taxpayers, or the actual tax, whichever is less. Donations are accepted pursuant to A.R.S. Section 43-1089. Donations must be postmarked or delivered to the association by December 31 to be claimed as a credit for the year.

## BENEFITS



The Arizona Private School Tuition Tax Credit law, A.R.S. Section 43-1089, allows Arizona tax-payers to make donations each year to the

### School Tuition Association of Yuma, Inc. (STAY)

Maximum Annual Private School Tax Credit:

1. Married taxpayers \$1,000
2. Single taxpayer \$ 500

You will receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit on your Arizona income tax return up to the amount of your income tax, or the amount of your donation, whichever is less.

The law allows a carry-over of any unused donations for up to five years.

The objective of STAY is to give the opportunity to attend a private school to more children by effectively implementing the provisions of the Arizona Private School Tuition Tax Credit.

- Up to 10% of total donations may be used for administrative costs and/or support of students who have incurred a hardship. The hardship students are submitted by the individual school boards for review and approval by the STAY Board of Directors.



## C-CORPORATIONS CAN DONATE

In September, 2006 Arizona Senate Bill 1499 created the corporate tuition tax credit which allows for corporations to receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for donations to charitable organizations that provide scholarships for children to attend the private schools of their choice.
